1. Þis sindon þā tācna þe mon on mynstre healdan sceal, þær mon æfter regoles
bebode swīgan haldan wile, and geornelice mid godes fultume begȳman sceal.
2. Gyf þē meolce lyste, þonne strocca þū þīnne wynstran finger mid þīnre swyþra
handa þām gelice swylce þū melce.
3. Gyf þū buteran habban wylle oððe smeoru, þonne strīc þū mid þrīm fingrum
on þīne innewearde hand.
4. Donne þū [sealt] habban wylle, þonne geþēoddum þīnum þrīm fingrum hryse
þīne hand, swylce þū hwæt seltan wylle.
5. Huniges tācen is þæt þū sette þīnne finger on þīne tungan.
6. Donne þū drincan wylle, þonne lege þū þīnne scytfinger andlang þīnes mūðes.
7. Bēores tācen is þæt þū gnīde þīne hand on þā Ȱþre.
8. Gyf þē wāteres genēodige, þonne dō þū swylce þū þīne handa þwēan wille.
9. Donne þū sāpan [h]abban wille, þonne gnīd þū þīne handa tōgædere.
